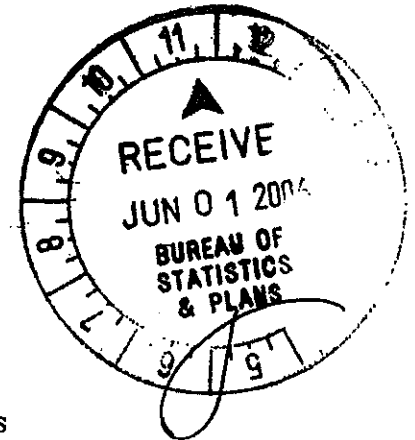

Hafa Adai!

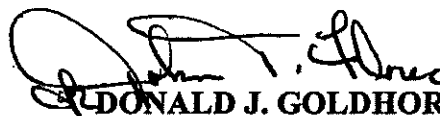
Our department is minimally impacted by increased military presence. DMA's role is, supporting the Guam National Guard (Army and Air) through an agreement known as the Master Cooperative Agreement (MCA). We do not provide any direct services to the community or other Gov-Guam agencies.

In general, increased military presence means increase demands on available resources. During periods of disaster, the guard when called to State of Active Duty (SAD), avails itself to whatever goods and services are available on island. Quick response operations will be hampered when other military services are competing for the same goods and services not to mention the needs of the civilian community.

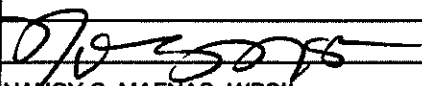
